Small, neat handwriting above the center of each measure

Tenuto Long Note Value



Long line under/above note head. (Tenuto)

Detached/ Short Notes



Slash between notes to indicate space

If "cresc." is written below your music, draw in the actual crescendo

Instrument Abbreviations

FI, Ob, Cl, B. Cl, Bssn, Alto, T. Sax, Bari, Tpt, Hn, Thone, Euph, Tuba, Perc (which one?)

Accidentals



Must put the accidental to the left of the note head, on the same line or space

Rehearsal Tempos

2/13=120

Date = tempo bpm

Peak of Phrase



Draw a star to indicate the peak of the musical phrase and direction, in addition to crescendo and decrescendo

Color Coding



Highlighter: Key/time signatures, repeats, roadmap Colored Pencils (red and blue): dynamics
